Information and Instructions for Undergraduate Readmission

Returning Students (Good Standing)

If you have not been enrolled for one year or more, complete the application and request that each institution attended since your last enrollment at WMU send an official transcript directly to the Office of Admissions. Once your file is complete, you will be notified and your GoWMU account will be reactivated.

Returning Students (Academically Dismissed)

If you were academically dismissed you must seek reinstatement to the University through the college in which you plan to re-enroll. Be aware that each college has its own processes and deadlines for students seeking readmission.

Take the completed application and copies of transcripts from each institution attended since your last enrollment at WMU to your advising appointment. The college will notify the Admissions Office of the readmission decision.

You must also request that an official transcript from each institution attended since you were last enrolled at WMU be sent directly to the Office of Admissions so that a credit evaluation can be completed. Once readmitted, you will be notified and your GoWMU account will be reactivated.

Returning Students (WMU Graduate seeking additional major or minor)

A graduate of WMU who no longer has registration status (has not been enrolled for one year or longer) and wishes to add an additional major or minor to the previously awarded degree should complete this application by responding 'yes' to item 14.

Prior Applicant or Admit (Never Enrolled)

If you applied and/or were admitted to WMU within the previous two years but never attended WMU, you must complete this application. Request that each institution attended since your last application to WMU send an official transcript directly to the Office of Admissions.
