A new version of the Training Course Outline (TCO) has been submitted to and approved by the FAA. Because of a desire not to change the TCO of a student mid course, students will be transitioned from an older version to the current TCO when they complete a particular FAA course and enroll in the next (e.g. transitioning from private to instrument).

Paper copies of the new TCO are available from dispatch and will be exchanged for free if you bring in your old copy of the TCO. New paper copies may be purchased from dispatch if you do not have your old copy.
