- your extracurricular activities, not simply what organizations you have joined, but what you did as a member – please include organizations not related to WMU
- your work experiences to date, and your home and family responsibilities
- the reasons you are applying for a scholarship
- what was most beneficial to you in your educational experience and why
- any other information that you believe would be helpful to the Committee in making its decision

If you are a transfer student, please attach a copy of your credit evaluations to this application. Your WMU records are available to us through the University database.

Instructions for Submitting Application Materials

All application materials must be typed or printed in black ink. Photocopying equipment does not reproduce blue or red ink, or pencil.

Please Do Not Staple application materials together. Paper clips will be available in the Office of Academic Advising and Admissions when you submit your materials. (Room 2130 Schneider Hall)

Complete the application, and the biographical sketch requested above. Submit your complete materials to Mr. Hal Bates, Office of Academic Advising and Admissions, by February 10. (If February 12, falls on a Saturday or Sunday, your materials will be due on the Friday before the 15th. In the case of University closure due to inclement weather on February 15, applications will be due at 12:00 noon of the next workday.)

Types of Awards

The Haworth College of Business Scholarship Committee decides on the distribution of scholarship money available to our students within 3 categories.

1. BUSINESS COMMUNITY AWARDS

These awards are usually based solely on your academic achievement within the College. Students are usually entering their senior year and are within the top 5% of grade point averages. Some major or home resident requirements may be considered.

2. ENDOWMENT AWARDS

These awards are usually based solely on a student's need factor. Grade point average must reflect good standing within the University. Applicant must be displaying progress toward graduation. If you are applying on the basis of need, please so indicate on your application and biographical information.

3. HAWORTH COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

These awards are funded by alumni donations. Awards are based on College achievement and extracurricular activities within the College and University.
