

## Charges to the Technology and Operations Council

Each of the Faculty Senate's councils has a number of ongoing charges. Those charges should be considered as renewed. In addition, the Faculty Senate Executive Board charges the Technology and Operations Council to consider, as a committee of the whole or through the appropriate sub-committee or task force, the following items:

1. producing a report on the state of the campus computing infrastructure, including, but not limited to, the functioning of and support for the local area networks around the campus. As part of this report the manager and support team, whether in the Office of Information Technology or not, should be clearly identified.;
2. making some attempts toward an assessment instrument or the means of assessing classroom technology. The fundamental question is whether or not a major focus should be placed on this area, and if it is, what sort of classroom technologies give us the most bang for the buck;
3. the classroom development charge has been removed from the Campus Planning and Finance Council, and is now the sole responsibility of TOC. The council should consult with Brad Morgan on the issue; and
4. reduce the number of outstanding charges.

Where appropriate, the work and deliberations of the council should result in policy or policies to be submitted for the consideration of the executive board and the Senate.

We further charge the council to work with the executive board through its council liaison to communicate questions or problems with the charges and their formulation to ensure that the business of the Faculty Senate is conducted in an appropriate and timely manner.
