Summer II 2009 Financial Aid Application
(June 25 – August 14, 2009)

1) You must complete a *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)* at www.fafsa.ed.gov for 2009-10 prior to receiving a financial aid award for Summer II semester .

2) Your aid for Summer II 2009 may include the following:

Federal Pell Grant If you are eligible for the Federal Pell Grant, then you will be awarded based on full-time enrollment. You may still receive Federal Pell Grant for less than full-time enrollment; however, it will be less than you would have received at full-time.

Federal Student Loans. If you are interested in federal student loans, then you will be awarded up to your maximum eligibility per your academic level and dependency status. Please check one of the boxes below:

Yes, I do wish to be awarded federal student loans in 2009-10 including Summer II.

No, I do not wish to borrow. Do not award federal student loans for 2009-10 at this time.

Federal Work-Study. Work-study funds are limited and may not be available for Summer II. If you would like to be considered for work-study then please complete the following:

Federal Direct Parent PLUS Loan. Parents and step-parents of dependent students may borrow the parent loan to help cover the cost of your education. A parent or step-parent will need to complete the Summer II Parent PLUS Loan application available on the web at www.wmich.edu/finaid.

3) If you are awarded aid, an award notification will be sent to your WMU e-mail account after this application has been processed and you will be able to view your award through GoWMU.

4) If you are awarded federal loans, they will be divided *evenly* between Summer II/Fall/Spring. Most students enroll in fewer credit hours in Summer II than in either Fall or Spring semesters. In general, students will receive a larger refund for Summer II than in later semesters.

5) *What next?*

✓ This application must be received at least 30 days prior to the last date of enrollment in Summer II.

✓ Check GoWMU to see if you have any missing documents that may delay your award.

✓ We will begin awarding aid for Summer II at the end of May. These forms will be processed in the order that they are received. To ensure that you receive your maximum eligibility, please submit this form as soon as possible.

6) *When will I receive my financial aid?*

✓ Federal aid can not be disbursed to your WMU account until after July 1, 2009.

✓ All other aid is scheduled to pay approximately 10 days before the start of the semester -- as long as you have completed all of your requirements. Not sure? Logon to GoWMU to see if you have unsatisfied requirements.
