2011-12 Documentation of Parental Non-Support

This form has been requested because you have submitted a 2011-12 FAFSA indicating that you are a dependent student for financial aid purposes, but did not supply parent information on your FAFSA.

Usually a dependent student must provide parent information to be eligible to receive any financial aid. However, under limited circumstances a dependent student can receive a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan without parent information if:

- 1) Your parents no longer provide *any* support for you, *and*
- 2) Your parents refuse to file the FAFSA.

CAUTION: Even if you are approved, you may lose out on financial aid that you would otherwise be eligible to receive. As a dependent student, without parental information on the FAFSA:

- You will not be eligible to receive any federal grants
- You will not be eligible to receive any Federal Direct Subsidized Loan
- You will not be eligible to receive most state grants including the Michigan Competitive Scholarship
- You will not be eligible to receive any need-based grants from WMU
- You will not be eligible to receive any work-study awards
