Position	Graduate Assistantship in Voice.
Responsibilities	Teach applied and/or class voice. Other duties based on qualifications.
Qualifications	Bachelor of Music degree or equivalent. Fine performer with teaching experience preferred. Admission to a Master's degree program in music.
Award	Full and partial assistantships available. Full assistantship consists of \$11,316 salary and tuition scholarship covering 12 credits (15 credits are normally taken each academic year).
Date of Appointment	August 2012.
