Rationale: The Specialist program in Educational Leadership meets a significant student need in higher education. The pending voluntary administrative certification for school administrators now being considered by the state legislature increases the need for this program. The program is fully integrated within the doctoral program and requires no additional resources independent of the doctorate. Program must develop enrollment management and resource allocation plan within two years.
