The Master of Arts Degree in Socio-Cultural Foundation should be maintained and allowed to complete college reorganization and program curricular reconfiguration. The program must be reevaluated in two years to determine if the changes have resulted in program improvements. Part of the rationale of this recommendation is that there were the errors made in data and that this program appears to be vital to the university's stated mission of enhancing teacher education and training. The reconfiguration must be done in a way that strengthens the program so that it remains competitive with other established and emerging programs within the state.
