Rationale: A proposal to delete the Master of Arts in the Teaching of Music (TMU) degree program has been approved by the School of Music faculty and is awaiting further curricular action within the College of Fine Arts; no students have been accepted into the TMU degree since Fall 2004.

Recommendation: It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the proposal to delete the Master of Arts in the Teaching of Music degree. Deletion of the program becomes effective at the conclusion of the 2011-12 academic year or the last graduation date of any currently enrolled students, whichever comes first.
