In Study Abroad

Eligibility.

All applicants must have earned at least 60, but no more than 105 credit hours toward an undergraduate degree in political science. Preference will be given to applicants with higher numbers of completed hours in political science. You must be a U.S. citizen, preferably, resident of the State of Michigan and a major in Political Science.

Criteria for Selection.

Students must have demonstrated overall academic excellence at Western Michigan University and, in particular, Political Science.

Amount and Duration of Award.

The amount of the award is up to \$1,000 for the academic year. Awarded in Fall 2008.
