



## Official's Information

All officials interested in working at the tournament must complete and submit an Official's Application. Applications can be submitted via mail or fax to the address on the form by January 28, 2011.

### **What to do I bring to the tournament?**

We encourage everyone to bring NFHS approved officiating gear. However, in some cases not everyone will have access to those items. All officials must bring the following items with them:

- Officials Stripes shirt
- Black pants/shorts
- Black shoes
- Whistle/Lanyard (bring a back-up just in case)
- Driver's License and social security card for payment

### **What do you get for working the tournament?**

- \$75 stipend for the tournament. Hours worked have to be submitted through the WMU payroll system, so you will receive your check a couple weeks after the tournament.
- Experience in working 3-person mechanics
- Complimentary hotel on Friday and Saturday
- Breakfast buffet provided by the hotel on Saturday and Sunday
- Official's Workshop on Friday night
- Access to the hospitality room with food and beverages
- Lunch on Saturday and Sunday
- Social on Saturday night with dinner
- Evaluations and immediate feedback on crew mechanics and rule interpretations.
- Networking opportunities with recreational sports professionals and other students.
- An opportunity to tell your family and friends that there really is a Kalamazoo and you have been there.

Each official must complete and submit the Official's Application and Code of Conduct Form by January 28, 2011. Once your information is received, we will e-mail you a confirmation on your attendance and provide additional need-to-know information.
