



Tournament Information

Entry Deadline

Entry form and payment must be received by February 4, 2011.

Entry Fee

\$300 per team (\$25 late fee for any registrations received after February 11, 2011)

No personal checks will be accepted. Payment must be by official University/Institution check, cashier's check or money order payable to WMU-SRC. Payment may be made by credit card by completing the credit card payment form. All refund requests must be received by February 4, 2011.

Rules

The 210-11 National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) basketball rules will govern play. Some modifications will be made for local rules.

Captain's Meeting

There will be a **MANDATORY** captain's meeting on Friday, February 11 at 7:30 p.m. in the Student Recreation Center. Failure to attend the meeting may affect a team's qualification for the tournament on Sunday.

Tournament Structure

Pool play is scheduled to begin at 8 a.m. on Saturday, February 11. If necessary to accommodate teams, play may begin on Friday night, but teams will be notified in advance. Pools will be made up of four teams, and all teams will be guaranteed three pool play games. The top two teams from each pool will advance to a single-elimination championship. Pool play schedules will be handed out to team captains at the captains meeting on Friday, February 11 at 7:30 p.m. in the Student Recreation Center. At the completion of pool play on Saturday, the tournament bracket will be available on-line and at the Student Recreation Center. There must be a minimum of four teams to in a division to be eligible for the prize package.

Jerseys

All players are required to wear the same color numbered jerseys for their games. It is strongly suggested that you bring a light and dark colored jersey for the tournament.

Awards

- Men's and women's champions will receive a paid entry fee and travel stipend to the NCCS National Basketball Championships at University of Texas in Austin. All divisions must have at least four(4) teams in order to receive the prize package. Stipends will be given to teams after the national championships.
- Individual awards to the champion and runner-up teams in each division
- Championship plaque for division winners for their institution
- Awards for All-Tournament team and Tournament MVP in each division
- Top official will receive a bid and travel stipend to NCCS National Basketball Championships

Check-in

All teams must be checked-in by 7 p.m. on Friday, February 11, 2011. Check-in will be located on the 3rd floor of the Student Recreation Center.

Parking

Teams will be provided with a maximum of two(2) parking passes. Additional parking passes may be purchased at the time of check-in. The parking pass provides direct access to the parking structure across the street from the Student Recreation Center. We will not be responsible for teams receiving parking tickets for improper parking.
