## Tuition

### Main Campus Tuition

Undergraduate tuition rates are based on the total number of credit hours earned. The number of credit hours for each level is printed next to that level.

## Extended University Programs Tuition Rates

*The tuition and fee rates quoted below are subject to change by the Board of Trustees.*

Students enrolled in Extended University Programs courses are charged the same tuition rates below. However, students registering for courses at the WMU-Traverse City Campus will be assessed an additional rate of \$10 per credit hour.

Undergraduate	\$266.60/hour
Graduate	\$345.80/hour

## Drop/Add Policy

The official registration drop/add period extends five business days into a semester or session. In addition, a 24-hour grace period will be provided to students who drop or add a course that meets for the first time on or after the final day of the drop/add period (late fees will apply).

Students are responsible for obtaining the work missed in course sessions not attended. Instructors are not obligated to update students who add a course after the first class meeting.

### Summer I

### Summer II

Drop/Add Period	Feb 14 - June 29

## Refund Policy

The University Business Office will grant refunds for student tuition for any decrease in hours according to the schedule below.

### Dropped Courses

Students may drop courses during the Drop/Add period. If a student drops a course, a refund will be awarded as follows:

Summer I: May 2 - 6	100%
Summer II: June 23 - 29	100%

### Complete Withdrawal

Processing a complete withdrawal from all courses, refunds will be awarded as follows:

#### Summer I

May 13	.50%
May 27	.25%

There will be no refunds awarded for complete withdrawals after May 27, 2005.

#### Summer II

July 5	.50%
July 20	.25%

There will be no refunds awarded for complete withdrawals after July 20, 2005.
