Dr. Sally Hadden, WMU professor of History, is a legal historian of early America and the antebellum United States. Dr. Hadden will speak about the forerunner of judicial review: the process of appealing cases for a rehearing from the American colonies to the Privy Council in England--and the steps colonial politicians took to prevent those appeals from happening. This restriction on access to justice by appeal put some colonists at odds with their own political leaders.
