| Criminal background check through <u>castlebranch.com</u> . This is recommended during fall of the sophomore year; it expires after one year. |
| When all of the above are completed, submit an application to the College of Education and Human Development Advising Office (2421 Sangren Hall). Applications are accepted on a rolling basis, but must be submitted prior to the fall semester when you wish to begin methods. |
| Complete the music core in theory/history/aural skills and conducting (MUS 2150); all must be completed with a "C" or better, and you must have at least a 2.5 GPA in theory/aural skills/history classes: |
| Basic Music 1600, 1610, 2600, 2610 Aural Skills 1620, 1630, 2590 Music History 2700, 2710 |
| Have no grade of less than "C" in Applied Music and successfully complete the Sophomore Hearing. |
| Submit an application to the music education area during the Spring semester prior to when you wish to begin methods. Applications are available through wmich.edu/music/resources. |
