- ★ Complete Western Michigan University's online application at www.wmich.edu/apply
Please note your status as a military dependent in the application. Please ensure that after you complete the online application (include application fee) to submit a copy of official transcripts from all other institutions attended to WMU. - ★ Turn in the Veteran's DD214 and your birth or marriage certificate during the application process to receive in-state tuition.
-How the Veteran can receive their DD214: You can obtain a certified copy from your local County Records Office or the Commission Office, if you previously had it recorded. If not, to obtain a copy of your military record, you can make an electronic request at www.archives.gov/veterans/military-service-records.
- ★ Apply for Benefits.
-Complete the application for VA Education Benefits (VONAPP) online at vabenefits.vba.va.gov/. When the application process is complete, the VA will issue a Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Please submit a copy of your COE to Brenda Hamlyn.
-If you have questions about applying for your benefits, please contact Billy Clayton.
- ★ Submit WMU Veterans' Certification form.
-To receive GI Bill benefits, students, along with the veteran's DD214 need to submit the WMU Veterans' Certification form to Brenda Hamlyn. Please visit www.wmich.edu/registrar/students/veterans/forms/ to receive a copy of the WMU Veterans' Certification form.
