SPAN 6770 (3 credits)	MOVIMIENTOS ARTÍSTICOS, CULTURALES Y LITERARIOS Taught by a professor from the Universidad de Cantabria <i>Study of the major artistic movements as they apply to art, culture and literature. Course includes visits to important sites.</i>
SPAN 6900 (3 credits)	TALLER PREPARATORIO PARA LOS EXÁMENES DE MAESTRÍA Taught by professor Pablo Pastrana-Pérez (WMU) <i>Prepare your M.A. comprehensive exams in a personalized way, tailored to your needs, and centered on your three areas of specialty as well as your coursework. Familiarize yourself with major artistic movements, literary currents and linguistic theories, as you learn to apply them to the works in the M.A. reading list. Course includes workshops at the library.</i>

- Eligibility**
- Students in a Spanish graduate program at WMU
 - Students with an undergraduate degree in Spanish must obtain graduate non-degree status at WMU.
- Cost**
- **Approximately \$3,800** program fee, which includes tuition (for both courses), insurance, and administrative fees, as well as housing, laundry, meals, and cultural trips.
- Scholarships**
- There are sizable scholarships available from the Department of Spanish and the Office of Study Abroad.
