 - **Action:**
 - Links to an external style sheet.
 - **Purpose:**
 - Allows you to link to a style sheet that can overwrite the defaults set by the Template.
 - **Type:**
 - URL
- doctitle
 - **What it does:**
 - Applies the determined value to the following elements:
 - 1) <title> tag,
 - 2) breadcrumb,
 - 3) the <h2> tag in the <div id="cMasthead">, and

Note: the <h2> tag is visible only when images are disabled (i.e. text-only viewing).

- 4) the header optional region's <h2> tag.
- **When to use it:**
 - Use this on every Web page you create with the template.
- **Type:**
 - Text
- layout
 - **What it does:**
 - Enables and disables columns.
 - **When to use it:**
 - When you need to change the number of columns in the individual Web page's layout.
 - **Type:**
 - Text (using only the pre-determined values, below)
 - **Values:**
 - layout1 (For a 1-column layout.)
 - layout2 (For a 2-column layout.)
 - layout3 (For a 3-column layout.)
- masthead_img
 - **What it does:**
 - Creates a path to your masthead.jpg image.
 - **When to use it:**
 - Whenever you need a masthead image, which is **always**.
 - **Type:**
 - URL
- office_email
 - **What it does:**
 - Posts your Web site's office's e-mail address in the footer of every Web page.
 - **When to use it:**
 - Provides the user with easy access to contact information—which is **always**.
 - **Type:**
 - Text
- office_fax (will become optional)
 - **What it does:**
 - Posts your Web site's office's e-mail address in the footer of every Web page.
 - **Type:**
 - Text
- office_phone
 - **What it does:**
 - Posts the parent office's phone number in the footer of every Web page.
 - **Type:**
 - Text
- office_title
 - **What it does:**
 - Posts the title of your Web site's office in the footer of every Web page.
 - **Type:**
 - Text
- office_zip
 - **What it does:**
 - Posts the zip code of your Web site's office in the footer of every Web page.
 - **Type:**
 - Number
- splash_alt
 - **What it does:**
 - Applies the determined value to the alt tag for the splash.jpg image.

- **When to use it:**
 - Whenever you want a text-only supplement for the splash.jpg image (e.g. displaying a tag line for a text-only version of the Web site, or when printing without images)
- **Type:**
 - Text
- splash_div
 - **What it does:**
 - Reveals the <div id="cSplash"> section.
 - **When to use it:**
 - On the home page of your Web site.
 - **Type:**
 - Boolean
- splash_img
 - **What it does:**
 - Creates a path to your splash.jpg image.
 - **When to use it:**
 - Whenever you need a splash image, which is **sometimes**.
 - **Type:**
 - URL
- top_button
 - **What it does:**
 - Enables/disables the "Top" button in column two of the layout.
 - Note: This feature is not available for a 1-column layout.
 - **When to use it:**
 - Whenever you want to provide customers a method to easily return to the top of the Web page.
 - **Type:**
 - Boolean
- website
 - **What it does:**
 - Applies the determined value to the following elements:
 - 1) the alt tag for the masthead.jpg image, and
 - 2) the <h1> tag in the <div id="cMasthead">.

Note: the <h1> tag is visible only when images are disabled (i.e. text-only viewing).
 - **When to use it:**
 - Whenever you want to provide text-only supplements for the masthead.jpg image; which is **usually**.
 - **Type:**
 - Text
