4. Register on BroncoJOBS by **Sept. 30** of sophomore year of study.
5. Agree to join Ts'ai Lun Registered Student Organization (RSO) each semester of study as a dues-paying member at \$10 per semester AND attend four Ts'ai Lun RSO meetings per year, two meetings per semester, to learn about industry jobs and corporations.
6. Must have held an internship or co-op by junior year to gain a senior year scholarship. (Successful placement requires critiqued resume and mock-interview sessions.)

Lack of participation at the PCI/PTF sponsored events and not achieving these requirements will result in your PTF Scholarship Award being rescinded and will be taken into consideration when awarding future PTF Scholarships.
