Classes taken at another university or college, or in either summer session at WMU, are not factored into your overall completion and cannot be used as part of your appeal. Credit hour completion and grade point averages are checked after each spring semester. If circumstances beyond your control caused or contributed to your deficiency, you should submit your appeal for review as soon as you receive your notice of deficiency.

The appeal process can be time consuming, depending on the number of students submitting appeals. The entire process, from the receipt of the complete appeal to the mailing of our decision, can take approximately two to four weeks. Therefore, we encourage you to return the appeal as soon as possible.
