The George Harding Scholarship was formed April 1984 to assist in educating juniors, seniors and first-year graduate school students interested in a bank-related career.

Scholarship Amount

\$1,000

Requirements for Scholarship Consideration

- 1. Full-time student (full time equals 12 or more credit hours per semester for undergraduate and post-graduate students, or nine or more credit hours for graduate and post-graduate students) must be a Michigan resident and attend a Michigan or out-of state college or university providing a four-year degree. Student must retain their Michigan residency.
- 2. Student must be pursuing at least a four-year degree.
- 3. Degree program must be finance-related; business administration, economics, agriculture, etc.
- 4. Student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.
- 5. Scholarships are provided after successful completion of the sophomore year for juniors or junior year for seniors.
- 6. Funds are paid directly to the college or university for credit to that individual's tuition expense for the following year.
- 7. The student must show promise and leadership qualities and be involved in campus activities.
- 8. Applications must be received by July 15 of the academic year for which aid is sought.

Goals

The goal of the scholarship fund is to provide annual scholarships from the interest earned on the trust's investments. As the fund grows, a perpetual scholarship fund is anticipated.
