Dr. Sean Field is the Clinical Director at Summit Pointe, Calhoun County's Community Mental Health Authority as well as a provider of mental health care and substance use services. Dr. Field will share information about the new Urgent Care Center, which opened in March 2021. The Urgent Care Center focuses on behavioral health and provides services to individuals experiencing psychiatric crises as well as increases access to service through service screening and coordination of care.
