**First year students take 9 credit hours in Fall & Spring semesters and three credits of practicum in summer II. Resident tuition is \$730.78 per credit hour, while non-resident tuition is \$1,096.17 per credit hours. However, students receive either a full or half-time graduate assistantship. A full appointment provides a stipend in the approximate amount of \$13,866 and tuition coverage for 18 credits (nine credits for both the fall and spring semesters). A half-time appointment provides a stipend in the approximate amount of \$6,933 and tuition coverage for 12 credits (6 credits for both the fall and spring semesters).
