## Western Michigan University Social Work Curriculum Guide

### Pre-Social Work requirements:

- Students who wish to major in social work will be admitted to the pre-social work curriculum at the time of admission to the University. This status does not guarantee admission to the professional social work curriculum.
- Upon completion of 30 credit hours of college level coursework and completion, or current enrollment in **SWRK 2100** (Social Work Services and Professional Roles), students may apply for admission to the School of Social Work. To submit the application, the student must have already been admitted to WMU. **Application deadlines** are **March 15** and **September 15** of each year.
- Please see the WMU social work website <http://wmich.edu/socialwork> for more details on how to apply to the program.
- Students must present a minimum 2.5 GPA to apply to the professional program. Selection is based on several criteria and is competitive, therefore 2.5 is a minimum and may not result in admission.

### General education requirements (WES):

- Students must fulfill the **Western Essential Studies (WES)** requirements for graduation from WMU. Please see the [WES transfer guide](#). Your community college advisor should be able to help you with this information.
- Please note, in the list below, that some of the required support courses (required of all social work majors) will also take care of some of the WES requirements.

**Important notes:**

- Students enrolled in the social work curriculum are required to complete a major consisting of 38 credit hours, required support courses of 22-24 credits, and 6 credits of research, totaling 66-68 hours.
- Also, part of the curriculum is a 400-hour internship at a human service agency.
- We are frequently asked whether foreign language is required of social work students. It is not required by the social work department, although it would be a good skill to have.
- Prospective transfer students should be aware that taking the SWRK 2100 class on WMU's campus will delay acceptance into the social work program by at least a semester. Most community colleges do not offer the 2100 course, so most social work students take the course at WMU. **NMC does not offer the course.**
