

# Spanish Department Video Contest



## GUIDELINES

- Open to all undergraduate students enrolled in Spanish courses at WMU.
- Videos must be in Spanish.
- Video's length should be between 4 and 8 minutes long.
- Dialogue should feel like a real-life conversation and should not simply be read.

## SUBMISSION

- Video files should be sent to Dr. M. Pérez de la Cruz, [mariola.perez@wmich.edu](mailto:mariola.perez@wmich.edu)
- The file must include: name of the student(s) participating, title of the video, and an e-mail address.
- Submission deadline: **MARCH 16<sup>TH</sup>, 2020**

## SELECTION CRITERIA

The best video will be selected by a committee of instructors from the Department of Spanish.

Videos will be judged on:

1. Language: actors should try to speak clearly and distinctively, and avoid mispronouncing words.
2. Script originality.
3. Content/Organization: the video must be creative, compelling and well thought out. A rich variety of supporting information in the video contributes to the understanding of the project.
4. Quality: movie must be well-edited and moves smoothly from scene to scene with proper use of transitions. Audio and other enhancements are well used.
5. Grammar and vocabulary: Complete mastery of grammar and vocabulary appropriate for the level.
