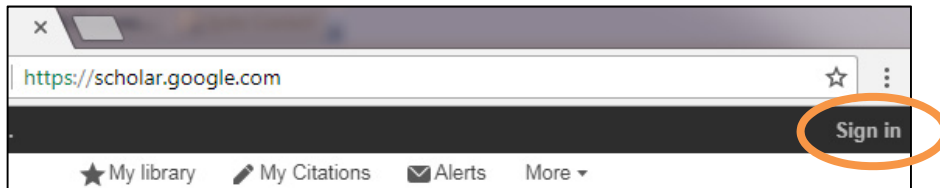




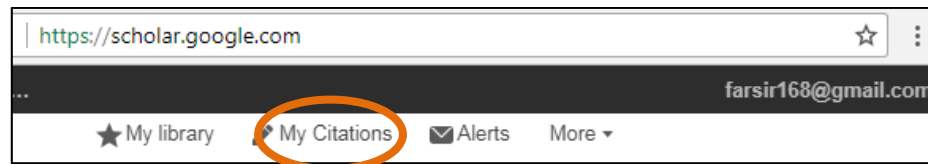
How to export publications from Google Scholar

If you store your publications in [Google Scholar](https://scholar.google.com), you can export the publications as a BibTeX format and import this file into WMU FARS.

- A. Type “scholar.google.com” in the address bar of your web browser and press the **Enter** key.
- B. The Google Scholar search page will appear. Click on Sign in in the top right corner.



- C. Sign in by using your Gmail address and password.
- D. Once you have signed in, click on “My Citations” to see your published articles.



- E. Select the citations you want to export by checking the boxes next to the citations. Then, click Export and select “BibTeX”.
