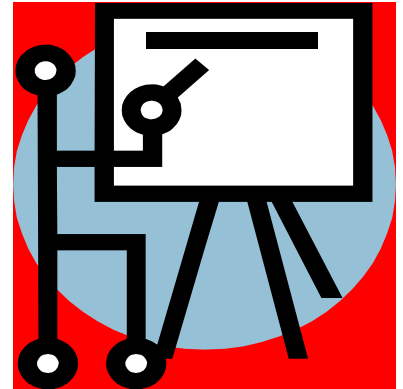

WHO CAN APPLY? Any student who is enrolled in the CoEHD

There are several scholarships that are awarded each year through the CoEHD and at least \$25,000 is designated for TRiO FESP Students every year! You only have to complete ONE application and the CoEHD Scholarship Committee will screen applications for the numerous CoEHD scholarships.

If you are a TRiO FESP Freshman in Marcy or M'Myia's FYE sections, you will complete this application as a classroom assignment.

WHO CAN APPLY? Any WMU Student who meets the specific criteria of each scholarship. There are several scholarships and you will need to read the eligibility requirements for each one.
