## Western Michigan University - Indoor Air Quality Management Program

WMU currently has an IAQ management program in place in 29 buildings or 3,365,757 square feet of building space. The buildings that fall under the IAQ management program currently have one or more types of air quality monitoring through the building automation system and allow occupants to register complaints through the maintenance work order system. Any alarms or work orders received that affect IAQ will either be addressed through the environmental control center or dispatched directly to technicians. Alarms and work orders will be addressed using standard operating procedures/action plans.
