Package Shipping Instructions

Exhibitors are welcome to send their materials to the College of Aviation prior to the event. Any materials must be sent by FedEx or UPS only, and WMU is not responsible for any shipping costs. WMU will ensure materials are ready and at your booth upon your arrival.

- FedEx and UPS are the only vendors that can be used for shipping to WMU
- Arrange delivery to WMU so the package will arrive between March 30 and April 4,

- Please record the tracking number for packages shipped to WMU for Aviation Outlook Day
- Return labels MUST BE PRINTED by the employer and attached to the outgoing packages for shipment. Packages cannot be sent without a return label
- WMU will gather return packages after the event, and send them out no later than Tuesday, April 9, 2024
