
This agreement shall commence as of Fall 2022. This program agreement shall abide by all language of the Institutional Agreement between Kellogg Community College and Western Michigan University.

Candidates for a degree or certificate from Kellogg Community College must meet specific requirements including the completion of a minimum of sixty (60) credits hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. All degree requirements are listed in the Kellogg Community College Academic Catalog.

All first-time, degree-seeking, KCC students must complete the **FYS 101 - First-Year Seminar** course with a grade of C or higher. Students who obtain an Associate degree or an Associate of Applied Science degree will be required to complete a service-learning experience.

Candidates for a degree or certification from Kellogg Community College must successfully meet the Bruin Standard of General Education which is the combination of academic General Education outcomes and outcomes met through co-curricular experiences.
