This agreement shall commence as of Fall 2022. This program agreement shall abide by all language of the Institutional Agreement between Kellogg Community College and Western Michigan University.

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All first-time, degree-seeking, KCC students must complete the [FYS 101 - First-Year Seminar](#) course with a grade of C or higher. Students who obtain an Associate degree or an Associate of Applied Science degree will be required to complete a service-learning experience.
