This agreement shall commence as of April 17, 2023. This program agreement shall abide by all language of the Institutional Agreement between Kellogg Community College and Western Michigan University.

Kellogg Community College is fully accredited by the [Higher Learning Commission](#). Candidates for a degree or certificate from Kellogg Community College must meet specific requirements including the completion of a minimum of sixty (60) credits hours with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. All degree requirements are listed in the Kellogg Community College Academic Catalog.

All first-time, degree-seeking, KCC students must complete the FYS 101- First-Year Seminar course with a grade of C or higher. Students who obtain an Associate degree or an Associate of Applied Science degree will be required to complete a service-learning experience.

Candidates for a degree or certification from Kellogg Community College must successfully meet the Bruin Standard of General Education which is the combination of academic General Education outcomes and outcomes met through co-curricular experiences.

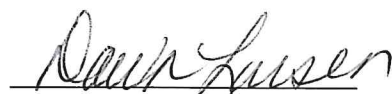
