GoReact Release Form

Teacher Candidates from WMU are periodically asked to record themselves teaching. This enables their instructors and their cooperating teachers to give them specific feedback on their teaching practices. It also enables them to critique themselves in order to learn and grow as teachers.

WMU utilizes a secure online video platform called GoReact (<https://get.goreact.com>). Video recordings that are uploaded to GoReact will be used for educational purposes only. The only people who will view these videos are the teacher candidate, the cooperating teacher, and the WMU faculty or staff who supervise the student teacher. Student personal information will not be associated with any video recording.

Although the student teacher will be the main focus of these videos, it is possible that the faces of students may sometimes appear on camera. As a result, before any video is recorded, WMU is required to obtain the consent of individuals 18 years of age or older, or the consent of a parent/guardian for individuals who are younger than 18.
