

GSA Budget Legend - Revenue

Rollover	This indicates the amount of money that remained unused by the Graduate Student Association in the previous fiscal year. These unused funds rollover to the next fiscal year and are also known as “carryforwards.” The fiscal year begins July 1.
Summer II SAF	This indicates the amount of money that GSA receives from the Student Assessment Fee (SAF) paid by WMU grad students for the Summer II session. Because the fiscal year begins July 1, this is the first new revenue GSA receives each year. For more info on the SAF, please visit https://wmich.edu/registrar/tuition-semester-fees
Fall SAF	This indicates the amount of money that GSA receives from the SAF paid by WMU graduate students for the Fall semester.
Spring SAF	This indicates the amount of money that GSA receives from the SAF paid by WMU graduate students for the Spring semester. It is generally expected to be 10% less than the Fall SAF transfer.
Summer I SAF	This indicates the amount of money that GSA receives from the SAF paid by WMU graduate students for the Summer I session.
Sweep Allocations	This indicates the amount of money that remained unused by the RSOs or individuals to whom funding was awarded through the Graduate Financial Allocation Committee (GFAC). Any unused award funds are put back in the GSA general fund at the end of the fiscal year (June 30).
