

## THE GEOSCIENCES GRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

### Eligibility:

- Graduate student must be a U.S. citizens or permanent resident.
- The scholarship will be awarded to a graduate student completing a thesis or dissertation that uses core materials in MGRRE and advised by a faculty member in the Department of Geological and Environmental Sciences. First preference will be given to a graduate student conducting core-related research using cores from the Michigan Basin.
- Completing a thesis or dissertation in the area of sedimentary geology or stratigraphy. The recipient's research project may focus on geochemical, geomechanical, petrological, diagenetic, stratigraphic, and/or geoenvironmental aspects of sedimentary geology/stratigraphy but should have potential applications to oil, gas or mineral exploration.
