The process to support academic integrity is managed and facilitated by the Office of Student Conduct

OSC staff meet with all students alleged to have violated academic integrity policies

It's time for faculty and student appointments to the Academic Integrity Committee!

Serve as panelists to adjudicate cases of alleged academic misconduct:

- Plagiarism
- Cheating
- Complicity
- Multiple submission
- Fabrication/falsification/forgery
- Computer misuse

Promote academic integrity, the policies, and the procedures around campus and in your academic departments

Every academic department is expected to appoint

- One faculty member for a three year term
  - Serve through the end of Spring 2024 semester
- One graduate student (if the department teaches graduate course) for a one year term
  - Serve through the end of Spring 2022 semester
- One undergraduate student (if the department teaches undergraduate courses) for a one year term
  - Serve through the end of Spring 2022 semester

Based on past case numbers, if OSC has a full panelist roster

- Each faculty member would serve an average of 3-4 times annually
- Each student member would serve an average of 2-3 times annually

Currently, less than 20% of the appointments are filled, including those returning for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> years

In need of panelists from across campus with diverse experiences and identities to serve!

Chairs will receive an email asking for departmental appointments If you are interested, please talk to your chair! Deadline for appointments is January 22, 2021 Virtual training will take place February 4 and 5

Panelists choose one training to attend based on availability
