
WMU Athletics is committed to:


- Providing a Safe Inclusive Space. A place where all are welcome ... every race, color, creed, sexual orientation and religion.

- Creating Real Change. Using community service, volunteer activities and outreach programs to continue to spread our message beyond the WMU Athletics community.




