Federal Compliance



- **Due March 15, 2021**
- Provides evidence towards adherence to Federal and HLC policies.

Status: Performing final update to links/evidence and reconciling with assurance argument.

COVID-19 Response



- **Due March 15, 2021**
- Information collected is used to inform peer review team of institutional adaptations due to COVID-19.
- Limits the scope of the assurance argument to non-pandemic operations.

Status: Performing final updates for review by senior leadership.

Assurance Argument



- **Due March 15, 2021**
- Criterion teams completed writing first drafts Summer 2020
- Internal peer review team provided feedback Fall 2020
- Core team has revised, incorporated feedback

Assurance Argument



- Individual core components have been shared for review by areas of responsibility.
- Feedback, revisions, updated evidence has been incorporated.
- Review by senior leadership and load to HLC filing system is in process.

- One on-site reviewer on campus April 12 only.
- Schedule to be determined.
- Peer review chair will coordinate with ALO
