SJF Sub-committee Interest Form

This interest form is to provide more effective avenue through subcommittees, to complete the four goals outlined in the Student-Led Social Justice Fund. Members are to rank their committee preference from most interested (1) to least interested (4) based on their passion, dedication, and expertise on the matter. The descriptions for the committees are as follows:

Affinity Space Committee: Chaired by Dr. Candy McCorkle

This committee will help advocate for the creation and implementation of affinity spaces for marginalized students at WMU. As of now, affinity spaces can be held in the Bernhard center until August of 2021 but will need a more permanent location. This committee is tasked with finding a home for affinity spaces as well as determining the management, funding, and rules of these spaces to ensure its legacy. This implementation will impact the recruitment and retention of students and faculty and foster a connection between students and their respective cultural communities.

Scholarship Committee: Chaired by Monica Liggins-Abrams

This committee will help implement a new Social Justice Fund Scholarship to provide more available financial support for students. It's been shown that the retention for Sophomores and Juniors is rapidly decreasing due to financial hardships and lack of support awareness. This group is tasked with identifying qualifications for scholarship, appropriate description verbiage, as well as funding avenues from donors to ensure its legacy. Students can benefit from added financial assistance and utilizing the creation of a scholarship opens opportunities for students to continue learning.

Faculty Recruitment & Retention Committee: Chaired by TBD

This committee will help solidify a strategical avenue in recruiting and retaining faculty of color, to help increase WMU's student graduation rate and promote the university's pillar of diversity, equity, and inclusion. It's been shown that there is a positive correlation to student academic success and representative faculty of the same racial identity. This group is tasked with navigating the appropriate avenue for starting the conversation, creation of strategic plan to implement this goal for its intended result, as well as outlining possible funding resources to ensure its legacy.

Undergraduate Research Committee: Chaired by TBD

This committee will help bridge the gap between underrepresented students and undergraduate research opportunities to increase networking, mentorship, and success. Underrepresented students at WMU have experienced the lack of opportunity for them to participate in research or development, a resource at WMU that is highly funded and promoted but not always utilized. This group is tasked with identifying possible avenues of expansion to marginalized community's, available workspace on campus, and necessary funding to ensure its legacy. This expansion would improve the overall graduation rate by fostering a connection between students and their respective cultural communities through collaborative work with faculty of same or different backgrounds.
