

Undergraduate Studies Council Minutes of 8 February 2022

Call to Order

The regular meeting of the Western Michigan University Faculty Senate, Undergraduate Studies Council was called to order at 3:04 p.m. on 8 February 2022, virtually via Webex by Clifton Ealy Jr., chair.

Quorum

A quorum was present.

Agenda

It was moved by Ehrhardt, seconded by Mason, to accept the agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

Minutes

Chair Ealy reported that he anticipates the council will be able to complete review of all outstanding proposals before the end of the academic year. Eberth's grant and Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs Jennifer Bott were recognized.

Ex Officio Slawinski reported on the awarding of student posthumous degrees and the possibility of changes to the student code.

Unfinished Business

Ealy raised a question of transfer credits in relation to the Service Learning Course Approval Committee charges. Bush questioned the creation of service learning procedures, which Ealy clarified. <u>It was moved by Slawinski</u>, seconded by Riggs, to accept the committee charge to create procedures. With one abstention the motion carried.

Riggs stated that the student learning outcomes for proposal USC_CEHD1155_HPHE_New-Major-EventMgt.Fall22 had been updated since the last meeting. Ealy asked for a motion to approve the proposal. Totton asked about the establishment of an advisor for the program, which was verified by Ehrhardt and Mason, that it was addressed in the teaching resources section. Eberth called for a secret ballot given the extent of discussion at the previous meeting. Survey Monkey was used to conduct the vote. It was moved by Ehrhardt, seconded by Riggs, to approve proposal USC_CEHD1155_HPHE_New-Major-EventMgt.Fall22 with the revisions to the student learning outcomes. With two abstentions, four votes against, and five votes in favor, the motion carried.
