- September 2019 Provost launches One WMU Initiative
- March 2020 Planning process paused for Covid-19
- Summer 2020 One WMU Recommendations Finalized
- August 27, 2020 University College announced to campus
- September 1, 2020: University College becomes effective
- Spring/Summer 2021 Additional units merged into college
- October 8, 2021 Officially renamed Merze Tate College


