### Call to Order

The regular meeting of the Western Michigan University Faculty Senate Research Policies Council was called to order at 2:31 p.m. on 13 April 2023, via Webex video conferencing by Andre Venter, chair.

## **Agenda**

### **Reports of Officers**

## Reports of University Representative

Gabriel provided financial information on Support for Faculty Scholars Award (SFSA), Faculty Research and Creative Actives Award (FRACAA), Preparation and Publication of Papers and Exhibition (PPP&E).

Seker informed RPC on the hiring on an in-house patent attorney.

Byrd-Jacobs announced the Graduate Student Association (GSA) is pausing activities for the remainder of the 2022-23 academic year. The goal is to hold an election in Spring 2024 to install a new executive board who will begin working in Summer 2024.

Byrd-Jacobs reported that a total of \$86K+ was awarded this academic year to Spring Research and Travel Grants. Forty-two students participated in the Research and Creative Activities Day. All University Research and Teaching Effectiveness Winners will be recognized on 17 April 2023.

### **Reports of Council/Committee Standing Committees**

Ex Officio Hurwitz acknowledged Stamper for her work and coordinating FRACAA even after moving to a new position. Thirty-three proposals were submitted. Fourteen were recommended for funding without reservations by the panels. Four of six creative arts, one of seven qualitative scholarly, and eight of 20 quantitative sciences were funded.

Chair Venter shared the library research resources and responses by Gerry Rinna, Library Collections Manager.

### **New Business**

Ex Officio DeFulio facilitated the elections of officers for the 2023-24 academic year:

- Seker nominated Venter as chair. <u>It was moved by Seker, seconded by Hurwitz to elect Venter as chair.</u> The motion carried.
- DeCamp nominated Arugaslan as vice chair. <u>It was moved by DeCamp, seconded Venter to elect Arugaslan as vice chair. The motion carried.</u>
- There were no nominations for the position of secretary.

RPC members decided on the meeting modality for 2023-24 be alternating. <u>It was moved by Arugaslan, seconded by Venter, to approve alternating 2023-24 meeting format. The motion carried.</u>

Mays discussed National Science Foundation (NSF) Requirement for safe and inclusive working environment. Animal welfare insurance has been approved.

Seker introduced the Research Development Plan which is pending funding. Seker presented the WMU Career Bow. There are plans to find external mentors for pre-tenure faculty, especially in their first two years at WMU. Mentees will travel to campus and present at seminars for a modest stipend. Nominations will open soon.

Venter requested feedback on the RPC 2022-23 Annual Report.
