

PROPOSAL: Liquor License – Multiple Events

Western Michigan University, as non-profit entity, may apply for up to 12 Special Event Liquor Licenses through the Michigan Liquor Control Commission (“MLCC”) each year. The Application for the licenses requires formal controlling board approval. The events listed below in the Recommended Action will follow all policies and procedures related to serving alcohol on campus, MLCC rules and regulations, and will have TIPS trained servers for the alcohol.

Recommended Action

RESOLVED that Western Michigan University, through its duly authorized officers, make application to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission for a one-day special licenses for the sale of beer and wine for the following events:

- May 9-11, 2024 -- Alcohol sales at the Student Center during the annual Medieval Congress. Note: These Special Licenses will not be utilized if the Student Center Permanent License is approved by the event date.
- June 22, 2024 – Alcohol sales during an outdoor concert at Miller Plaza organized by WMU Auxiliary Enterprises.
- November 8, 2024 --College of Aviation Annual Hall of Honor Induction Ceremony dinner at the Aviation Education Center
