PROPOSAL: Delete the History: Secondary Education Major

Background

The Undergraduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the deletion of the History: Secondary Education Major offered by the Department of History in the College of Arts and Sciences.

After discussions over the past several years, CAS and the College of Education and Human Development (CEHD) decided to stop providing programs at the bachelor's level that lead to teacher certification. "History Major – Secondary Education" is one of the programs being deleted as part of this change. A total of 19 different majors and minors are part of this deletion process. A new Social Studies major has been proposed and, if approved, will provide the necessary content background for students who hope to pursue teaching certification in WMU's new MAT program.

Recommended Action

Delete the History: Secondary Education Major.
