See the *HESA multi-year course plan* for further details. (4) There are HESA guidelines for selecting focused electives, Diversity Cognate, Field and Capstone experiences. (5) All Diversity Cognates, Field Experiences, and Capstone **must be approved** by the faculty advisor prior to registration. (6) \*\*Students may take courses the summer before the Fall cohort (typically EDLD 6020 or Diversity Cognate); (6) There are prerequisites to be eligible for Field Experience and Capstone.
