(5) All Diversity Cognates, focused elective, Field Experiences, and Capstone **must be approved** by the faculty advisor prior to registration. (5) **Students may take courses the summer before the Fall cohort (typically EDLD 6020, Diversity Cognate, or focused elective); (6) There are prerequisites to be eligible for Field Experience and Capstone.
