

PROPOSAL: Conversion of Sociology-Social Psychology concentration to Social Psychology major

Background

The Undergraduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the conversion of the concentration Sociology-Social Psychology to a major entitled Social Psychology offered by the Department of Sociology in the College of Arts and Sciences. Per MOA 23/01

Concentrations were previously defined as separate academic programs in the July 8, 2015 revision of this policy. Concentrations have evolved since that time and in practice are technically the same as a major. To simplify the curriculum, no new concentrations will be created, and any curriculum change to existing concentrations must also change the concentration to a major.

Recommended Action

Convert the concentration – Sociology-Social Psychology – to a major – Social Psychology.
