PROPOSAL: Conversion of Counselor Education: Clinical Mental Health Counseling concentration to Clinical Mental Health Counseling program

Background

The Graduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the conversion of the concentration Counselor Education: Clinical Mental Health Counseling to a program entitled Clinical Mental Health Counseling in the College of Education and Human Performance. Per MOA 23/01

Concentrations were previously defined as separate academic programs in the July 8, 2015 revision of this policy. Concentrations have evolved since that time and in practice are technically the same as a major. To simplify the curriculum, no new concentrations will be created, and any curriculum change to existing concentrations must also change the concentration to a major.

Recommended Action

Convert the concentration – Counselor Education: Clinical Mental Health Counseling – to a program – Clinical Mental Health Counseling.
