PROPOSAL: Conversion of Geography: Environmental Geography concentration to Environmental Geography major

Background

The Undergraduate Studies Council of the Faculty Senate has approved the conversion of the concentration Geography: Environmental Geography to a major entitled Environmental Geography offered by the School of Environment, Geography, and Sustainability in the College of Arts and Science. Per MOA 23/01

Concentrations were previously defined as separate academic programs in the July 8, 2015 revision of this policy. Concentrations have evolved since that time and in practice are technically the same as a major. To simplify the curriculum, no new concentrations will be created, and any curriculum change to existing concentrations must also change the concentration to a major.

Recommended Action

Convert the concentration – Geography: Environmental Geography – to a major – Environmental Geography.
